I hold qualifications in the administration of Class 3B and Class 4 LASER.

I always abide by the Veterinary Surgeons Act 1966 and Exemptions Order 2015, by never working on an animal without veterinary consent. As stated by the RCVS, "Physiotherapy" is interpreted as including all kinds of manipulative therapy" (Section 19.21), thus including massage therapy. Manipulation under massage therapy is limited to (or refers to) soft tissue and testing a joint's range of motion. I do not manipulate joints like a chiropractor.

I specialise in the use of Myofascial Release, Sports Massage, Deep Tissue Massage and Swedish Massage, as well as Low Level Light Laser Therapy application.

I ensure continuity of client care by providing a written report back to the surgery upon completion of a client's initial sessions.

I comply with GDPR Compliance 2018 and the Data Protection Act 1998.

Canine Merishia Massage Therapy and Low Level Laser Light Therapy is suitable for soft tissue injury rehabilitation and for chronic pain management of orthopaedic conditions as well as pre and post-operative care. It is commonly used amongst sporting, performance and agility competitors too.
